# Maryland Crab Soup

Prep Time: 15 minutes

Cook Time: 30 minutes

Yield: 10 Servings

This crab soup is the real stuff – genuine Maryland crab soup, direct from the Chesapeake Bay area.

#### <u>Ingredients:</u>

- 2 (14.5 ounce) cans stewed tomatoes
- 3 cups water
- 2 cups beef broth
- 1 cup fresh lima beans
- 1 cup frozen corn kernels
- 1 cup sliced carrots
- 2 tablespoons chopped onion
- 2 tablespoons Old Bay Seasoning TM
- 1 gallon water
- 10 blue crab claws, steamed Optional)
- 1 pound blue crab crabmeat



#### Instructions:

- 1. Gather all ingredients.
- Place stewed tomatoes, 3 cups water, beef broth, lima beans, corn, sliced carrots, chopped onion, and Old Bay seasoning in a 4-quart pot. Bring to a simmer over medium heat; cover and cook for 5 minutes.
- 3. Bring 1 gallon water to a boil in a large pot. Add crab claws and boil for 6 minutes; drain.
- 4. Stir crabmeat and boiled crab claws into tomato and vegetable mixture. Cover and simmer for 10 to 15 minutes. Serve hot.

Kaylah plans to continue her education to become a doctor.



# TO YOUR GOOD HEALTH

# Men, Take Control of Your Health Now!

Men's Health Month aims to promote early identification and treatment of diseases like Hypertension, Prostate Cancer, and Stroke (Centers for Disease Control, CDC 2023).

#### Author's Note:

Men! The time is now to implement healthy living decisions, including exercise, diet, physical activities, and seeing your Primary Care Physician (PCP) on a routine basis. Remember, it is important to develop a trusting relationship with your doctors. Also, make sure that other doctors you might see have a relationship with your PCP so that the right hand knows what the left hand is doing. For example, if your PCP gives you high blood pressure medication, you want to be sure that any specialist you see does not give you a medicine that conflicts with other medications. Understand that Physicians in the same health group can see your medical records electronically without requesting them.

Note from The National Institute of Health (NIH): The NIH has Partnered with the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the National Cancer Institute to recognize men's health for the month of

#### Hypertension Prevention Tips:

- Control your blood pressure by yourself. You have the power to manage your blood pressure and lower your chance of developing diseases, including renal disease, heart attack, and stroke. For most people, controlling blood pressure means keeping it below 130/80 mmHg.
- Learn to check your blood pressure at home.

#### Prostate Cancer Prevention Tips

- Get Prostate Cancer Screenings every 2-3 years, depending on the results of previous tests and your healthcare provider's recommendations. Before deciding, talk to your doctor about the benefits and harms of screening for prostate cancer.
- If you are over 70, get screened on a routine basis.

#### Stroke Prevention Tips

- Consume meals high in fiber and low in cholesterol, trans fats, and saturated fats.
- Limit salt in your diet, maintain a healthy weight, exercise.
- Check cholesterol regularly and take your medication as prescribed.
