MINISTER'S THOUGHTS

The Pruning of Our God

John 15:2 - Amplified

2 ... every branch that continues to bear fruit, He (God) [repeatedly] prunes, so that it will bear more fruit [even richer and finer fruit].

Pruning means to trim (a tree, shrub, or bush) by cutting away dead or overgrown branches or stems, especially to increase fruitfulness and growth; to reduce the extent of (something) by removing superfluous, redundant, unnecessary, unneeded, and/or unwanted parts.

The plant doesn't understand the pruning process, even if the undesirable parts, determined by the gardener are hindering or killing the plant. The plant only recognizes that the gardener is using a sharp tool that has the capability of wounding, through the method of dismemberment. The plant is wondering why the gardener is dismembering me, if I am already producing fruit. The "Body of Believers" is asking the same question, because Christians see pruning as a method of losing a part of themselves.

In the natural, pruning is a type of surgery used by doctors to remove a foreign object that has the potential (over a period of time) of killing its host. As in natural, so it is in the spiritual, pruning is God (as the master surgeon), operating on the "Body of Christ," so we can continue to produce more richer and finer fruit! We might not like the process of the "Pruning of God" (cutting some unneeded associates out of our lives), but after we experience the purpose and the plan God has for our lives, it will be worth it all!

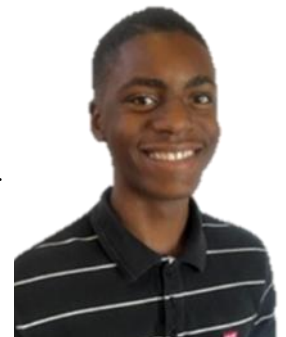

Banana Bread

RECIPES TO TRY

Prep Time: 15 minutes

Bake Time: 75 minutes

Total Time: 2 hours 30 minutes

Yield: 24 Servings

This crab soup is the real stuff – genuine Maryland crab soup, direct from the Chesapeake Bay area.

Ingredients:

- 1 ¼ cups sugar
- ½ cup butter , softened
- 2 eggs
- 1 ½ cups mashed very ripe bananas (3 - 4 medium)
- ½ cup buttermilk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 2 ½ cups Gold Medal™ All-Purpose Flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup chopped nuts, if desired

Instructions:

1. Move oven rack to low position so that tops of pans will be in center of oven. Heat oven to 350° F. Grease bottoms only of 2 loaf pans, 8½ x 4½ x 2½ inches, or 1 loaf pan, 9x5x3 inches.
2. Mix sugar and butter in a large bowl. Stir in eggs until well blended. Add bananas, buttermilk and vanilla. Beat until smooth. Stir in flour, baking soda and salt just until moistened. Stir in nuts. Pour into pans.
3. Bake 8-inch loaves about 1 hour, 9-inch loaf about 1¼ hours, or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes. Loosen sides of loaves from pans; remove from pans and place top side up on wire rack. Cool completely, about 2 hours, before slicing. Wrap tightly and store at room temperature up to 4 days, or refrigerate up to 10 days.

- God is love (John 3:16; Rom. 5:8; 1 John 4:8)

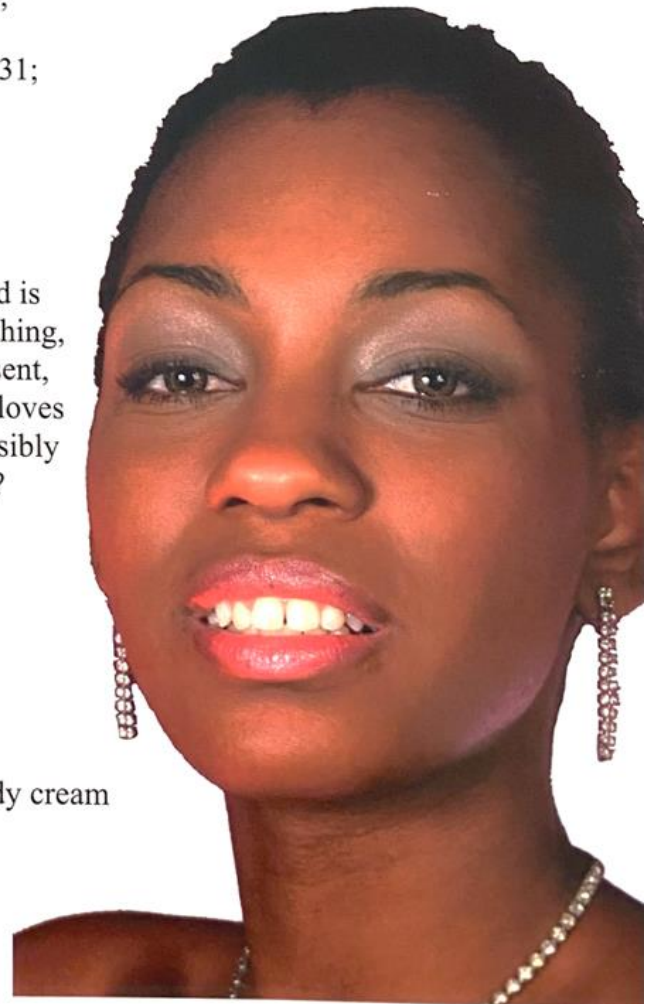

Mental Health Awareness

If you have ever experienced stress, depression, anxiety, or mental illness, I have GOD news for you! Those factors do not diminish your worth as a Christian. If your thoughts are due to trauma or other significant occurrences are so overwhelming that it causes great anxiety, depression, and stress, understand that the enemy attacks our minds first to trick us into thinking negatively and then move those harmful thoughts to feelings of anxiety, depression, or severe sadness. The enemy desires you to sink so far into depression that you cannot do what God created you to do: to give Him PRAISE, HONOR, and GLORY.

You see, the key here is to change your thought process. As children of God, we are required to refresh our minds to change ourselves and focus on our thinking. Romans 12:2 says, *"And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."* Therefore, it is imperative as Christians not to conform or to agree with some of the world's method of dealing with depression. In the medical world, some physicians suggest taking psychotropic medications to deal with severe sadness or depression. Psychotropic medications may or may not present the following symptoms:

- ◆ Changes in mood, behavior, lack of awareness of time and space
- ◆ Hallucinations, lack of feelings of intimacy for your spouse and children
- ◆ Changing the chemistry of the central nervous system, thus affecting one's body language and thoughts of suicide.
- ◆ Lack of interest in spending time with others, craving to be alone, thus separating oneself from the house of God - Where your strength resides,

Psychotropic medications can change the chemistry of the brain (www.genesisrecovery.com). God created us with his personal touch and gave us a physical body and a soul. Understanding that God took the time and crafted us in his image - lets us know that we were made strong enough to deal with the issues of life if we commit ourselves to His will. He did not just make us and leave us to our own devices. *"He said I would never leave you, nor forsake you."* (Deuteronomy 31:6 KJV). *"He said lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world."* (Matthew 28:20 KJV). Remember, *the thief cometh not, but for to steal, kill, and destroy.*

Conclusion

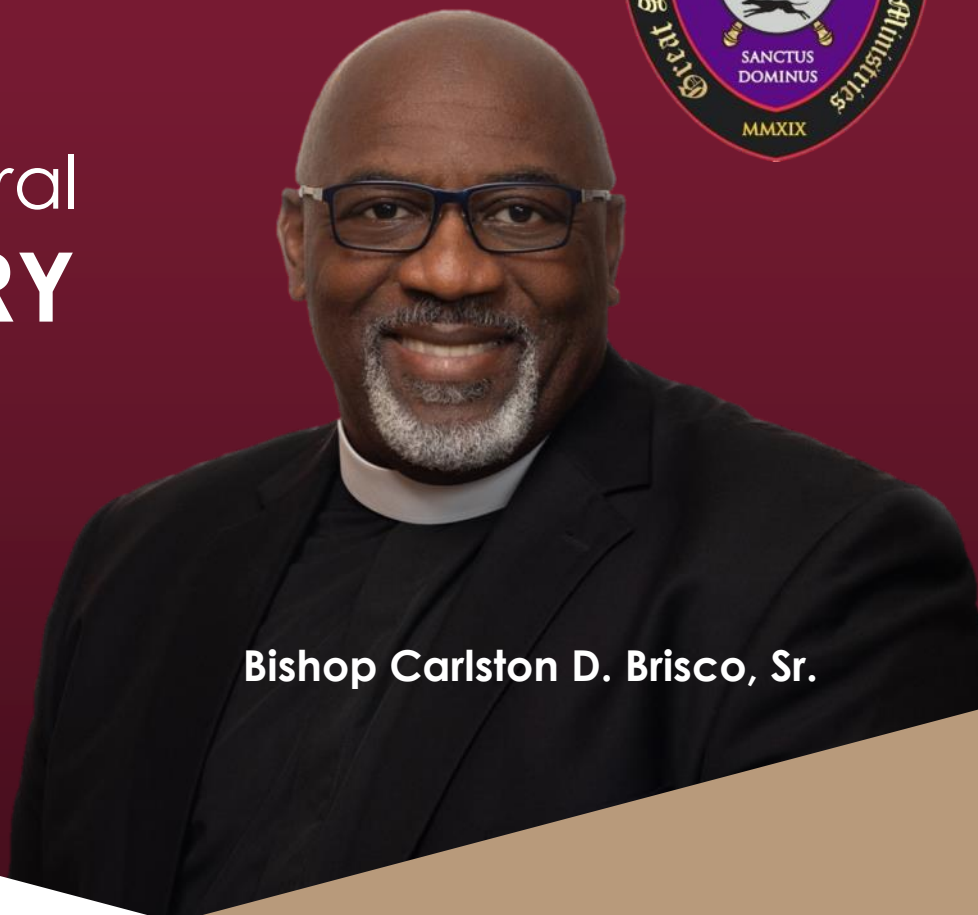

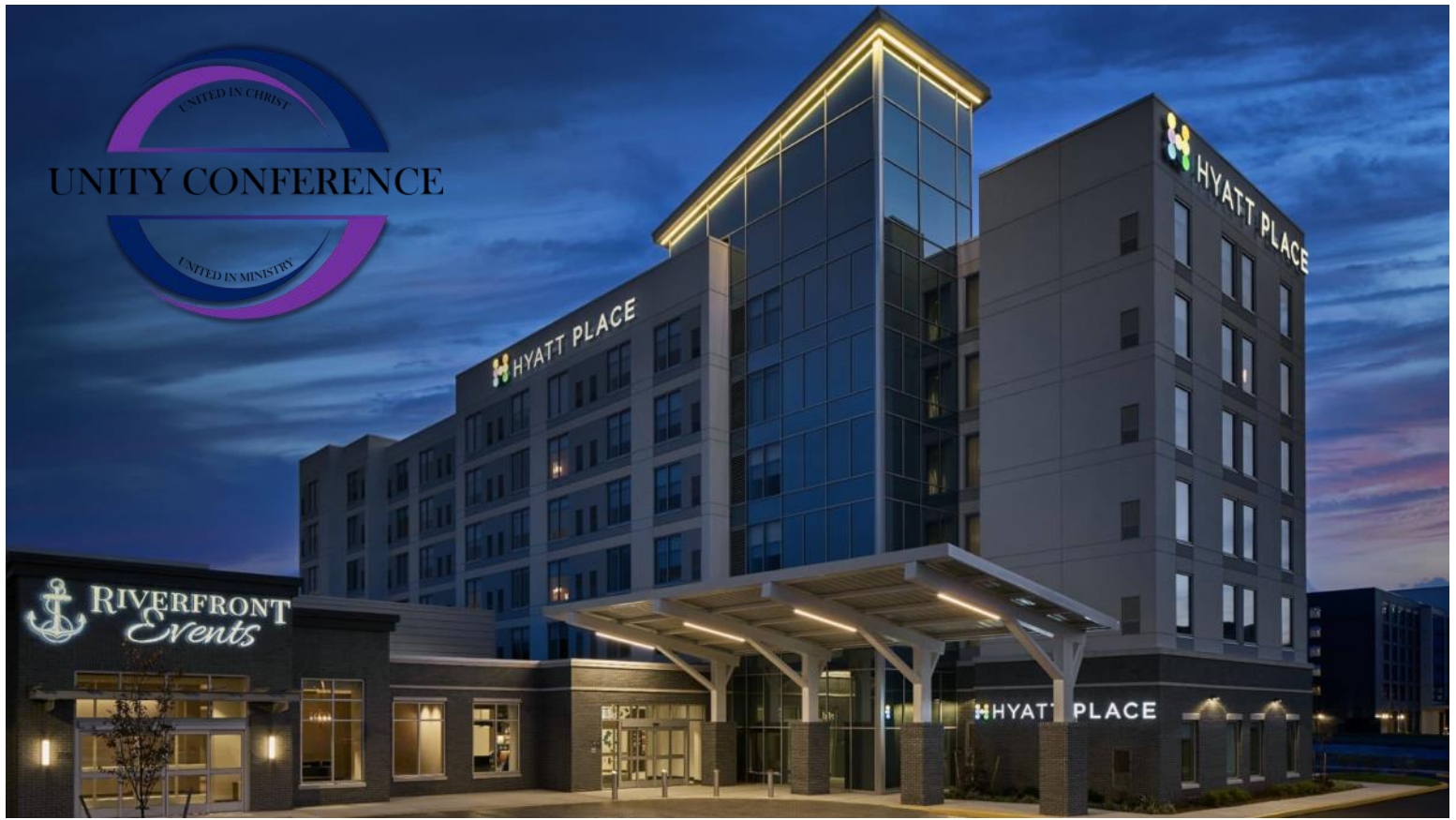
